### Room Inspection Expectations

Please note that room inspections will be performed by your Director of Housing and/or the Residential Assistants. It is the responsibility of all parties to maintain a clean and safe living area and shared spaces, such as restrooms. Assigning a cleaning schedule of shared areas, such as the restrooms, is at the discretion of the roommates/suitemates. However, all parties are responsible for the cleanliness and safe keeping of such areas. If you have any questions regarding the expectations and policies of room inspections, please advise your Director of Housing.

**Expectations:**

**\*All beds neat and made**

**\*Clothes either hanging in the closet or folded in dressers**

**\*Cleaned floors (vacuumed, swept, mopped)**

**\*Cleaned bathrooms (sink, shower, toilet)**

**\*Trash emptied**

**\*No evidence of smoke or illegal/banned items (drugs, alcohol, weapons, etc.)**

\*\* Director of Housing and Residential Assistants must also check for any damages to the dorms or items belonging to Virginia University of Lynchburg within the rooms (i.e. dressers, beds, walls, mirrors, etc.). Please make note that any evidence of illegal/banned substances, paraphernalia, and/or smoke within the dorms or common areas is grounds for immediate dismissal from campus housing.
